The Teaching Artist Specialist will support Refresh Collective teaching artists to provide a safe, creative and nurturing summer camp program to help students grow in confidence and new skills.

Responsibilities:

- Under the direction of Lead Teaching Artist
 - Learn and implement Refresh Collective curriculums

- Assist in preparing lesson plans
- Assist during student sessions.
- Create visual art, music and lyrics as needed alongside student projects.
- Learn how to run classes in recording studios, schools, and partner locations.
- Learn and practice the Refresh Collective student engagement and discipline strategies.
- Build bridges of trust with students, parents, schools, and program partners.
- Complete all data collection protocols
- Learn audio and visual edits and mixdowns of student audio/visual work.
- Set-up, tear down, and protect A/V equipment
